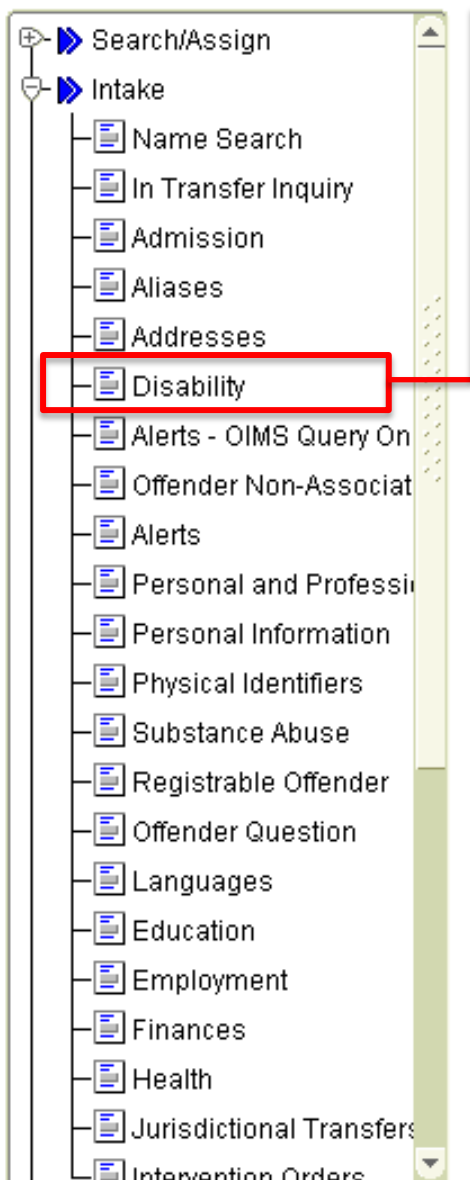

1. Scope and Purpose

For reporting purposes BSI Learning requires specific information about an inmate's disability. This can only be obtained through the Disability Intake Screen.

2. Accessing Disability Information

In OIMS select Intake – Disability.



Enter MIN and then CTRL F11, or click on 'perform the query'



You will need to refer to the Disability Type to ascertain the inmates identified disability.
